



October 14, 2010 PECO Procurement: Fall 2010 Solicitation Rate Impact

In the PECO Energy Default Service Plan settlement filing, which was approved by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission on April 16, 2009, parties agreed to the public release of certain information regarding the results of each solicitation 30 days after the solicitation (or 21 days before the supply period starts, whichever comes earlier). On September 24, 2010, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission approved PECO's request to release the results of the Fall 2010 Solicitation on October 14, 2010. The full text of the order is available on the PUC Web site here. The Fall 2010 solicitation was held on September 20, 2010 for supply starting on January 1, 2011.

The information in this document is provided in accordance with the PUC Order. The rate impacts specified below are aggregate figures calculated based on the results of all four solicitations to date.

Residential Class

Rate impact: 8.76 cents/kWh, indicating a 3 percent decrease for the average residential customer beginning 2011.

Small Commercial Class

Rate impact: 8.73 cents/kWh, indicating a 15.8 percent decrease for the average small commercial customer beginning 2011.

Medium Commercial Class

Rate impact: 8.54 cents/kWh, indicating a 9.6 percent decrease for the average medium commercial customer beginning 2011.
