



Results of January 2014 Solicitation Under PECO's DSP II

On January 30, 2014, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission issued a decision regarding the results of the January 2014 Solicitation under PECO's second Default Service Program ("DSP II"). As stated in the Secretarial Letter (Docket No. P-2012-2283641), the PUC approved "the 12-month residential, 12-month small commercial, 6-month medium commercial, and 12-month large commercial and industrial bid results, but rejected the 24-month residential bid results". In accordance with the PUC's directive dated October 12, 2010 (Docket No. M-2009-2082042), the results for each product procured in the January 2014 Solicitation are provided below.

For the Residential, Small Commercial, and Medium Commercial Classes, PECO has posted the actual Price to Compare for the periods December 1, 2013 – February 28, 2014 and March 1, 2014 – May 31, 2014 to its Web site. PECO expects to post its June 1, 2014 actual Price to Compare by March 17, 2014. For the Large Commercial & Industrial Class, PECO has posted the actual Price to Compare for January, February and March 2014 and expects to post its April actual Price to Compare by February 17, 2014.
