



Results of March 2020 Solicitation Under PECO's DSP IV

On March 11, 2020, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission approved the results of the March 2020 Solicitation under PECO's fourth Default Service Program ("DSP IV"). The [Secretarial Letter](#) is available on the PUC website.
